A NEW BEGINNING!

As a Unitarian Universalist Congregation, our River of Grass Community is “self-governed.” Our congregation names its own criteria for membership, calls its Minister, and controls its own budget. We intentionally covenant to learn together, support one another, and in community aspire to be something greater than our individual selves.

The highest level of decision-making happens within our congregation and not within some higher ecclesiastical body (such as bishops, presbyters, or regional staff).

This congregation is self-supporting through the financial stewardship of its members and friends.

We, as members and friends of the River, covenant to strive to be in relationship with each other and with the larger community in ways that build a safe, healthy, nurturing environment while strengthening our common bonds.

To this goal, we ask that our members and friends make a monetary commitment (pledge) to sustain our beloved community. From these we present an annual budget for approval by our membership. This process reflects our congregation’s support and priorities.

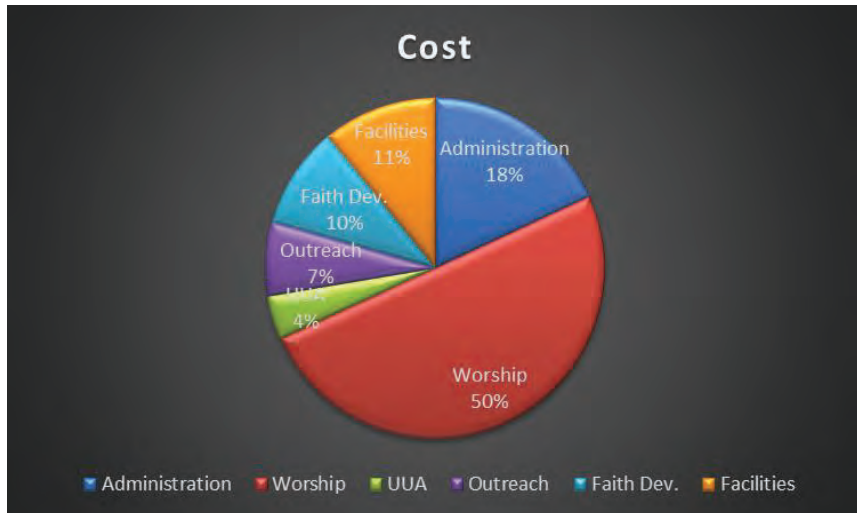

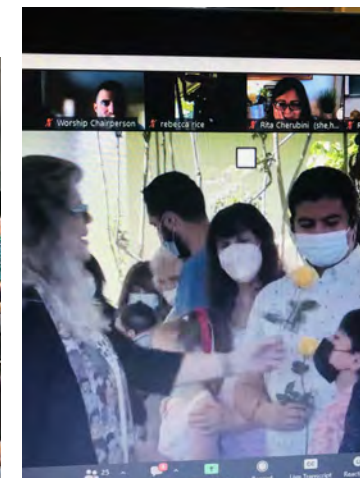

Some of us have felt safe to emerge from our COVID cocoons to meet together in person again.

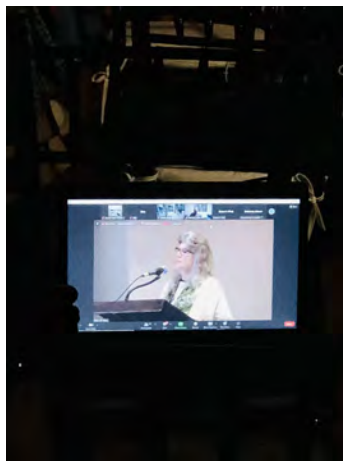

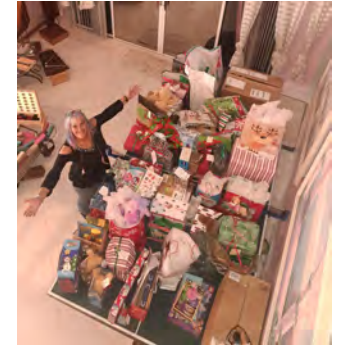

Remember our last 24/7 home in the 595 Park of Commerce? We miss it for sure! Stay tuned for the work of our New Home Team!

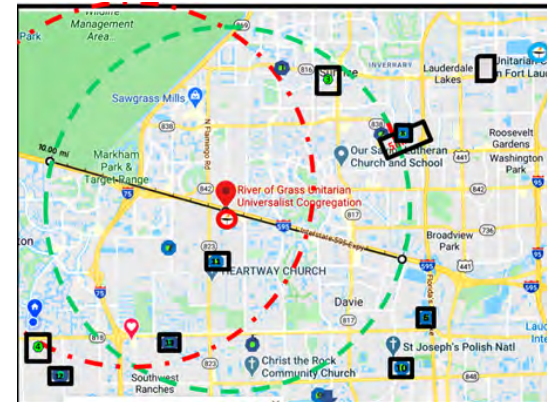
