Yes, Jane Addams, one of our Unitarian heroes, was labeled the most dangerous woman in the US. For her unrelenting work for social justice. She took on corrupt city officials, the court system, the state legislature, the labor industry, and even the president. Known best for her establishment of Hull House in Chicago, she was also responsible for changing child labor laws, the creation of Juvenile Court, eliminating sweatshops and so much more. She was an abolitionist, suffragette, and pacifist. Even though it was unpopular, she was outspoken in her opposition to the US entering World War I and the war in general.
